When June was 10, her father was diagnosed with AIDS and passed away shortly after. Her mother, Hosanna, also tested positive for HIV. The family faced emotional and financial devastation. Hosanna became severely ill but began taking ART (Antiretroviral Therapy), which helps manage HIV infection. With no source of income, their living conditions and the children's education suffered.

Referred to IICCHAA through the Positive Network, June and Hosanna received immediate nutritional support. Hosanna was trained in tailoring to generate income, and June's studies were supported through home visits and a private tutor. June also participated in life skills training.

Hosanna began working as a zari worker, allowing June and her sisters to continue their education. Now 17, thanks to support from the IICCHAA program, June has been promoted from class 11 to 12 and is doing well while helping her mother with zari work.
